WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY FOR MINORS

(IMPORTANT - READ BEFORE SIGNING!)

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the American Canoe Association, Inc. athletics/sports program, and related events and activities, particularly programs that are organized and supervised by the Rocky Mountain Sea Kayak Club, the undersigned agree to the following:

- Participant:** Prior to participating, I will inspect the facilities and equipment to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe, I will immediately advise a coach, instructor, supervisor, or other event organizer of such condition(s) and refuse to participate.
- Parent/Guardian:** As the parent or legal guardian of the participant I will instruct the minor participant that prior to participating, we will inspect the facilities and equipment to be used, and if I believe or the participant believes that anything is unsafe, we will immediately advise a coach, instructor, supervisor, or other event organizer of such condition(s) and refuse to participate.
- We acknowledge and fully understand that each participant will be engaging in activities that involve risk of damage to personal property or serious injury, including permanent disability and death, and severe social and economic losses which might result not only from my own actions, inactions or negligence, but the actions, inactions or negligence of others, the rules of play, the condition of the premises, or of any equipment used. Further, there may be other risks not known or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
- We assume all the foregoing risks and accept personal responsibility for all expenses, medical or otherwise, following any such damages, injury, permanent disability or death.
- We release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the American Canoe Association, Inc., its affiliated clubs, including the Rocky Mountain Sea Kayak Club, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches, members, volunteers, and other employees of the organization, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and leasers of premises used to conduct the event, all of which are hereinafter referred to as "releasees", from any and all liability to the participant, his or her heirs and next of kin for any and all claims, demands, losses or damages on account of injury, including death or damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.
- This waiver may not be modified in any way. If any part of this waiver is determined to be invalid by law, all other parts of this waiver shall remain valid and enforceable.

WE HAVE READ THE ABOVE WAIVER AND RELEASE, UNDERSTAND THAT WE HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND SIGNED IT VOLUNTARILY.
